The Meeting of Parishioners: only persons whose names are on the Church Electoral Roll of the parish or the persons resident in the parish and on the register of local government electors are entitled to attend and vote.

The Annual Parochial Church Meeting: only persons whose names are on the Church Electoral Roll are entitled to vote for parochial representatives of the laity.

- ⌘ A person is qualified to be elected a parochial representative of the laity if;
 - ~ His/her name is on the Church Electoral Roll of Wickham Parish
 - ~ He/she is a communicant of the Church of England (or of a church in communion with it)
 - ~ He/she is sixteen years and over for the election to the Parochial Church Council
 - ~ Any person whose name is on the Electoral Roll may be appointed sidesperson.
- ❖ All candidates for election at an annual meeting must be nominated and seconded by persons entitled to attend the annual meeting, and in the case of parochial representatives of the laity, by persons whose names are entered on the roll of the parish. Candidates for parochial representatives of the laity shall be nominated or seconded either before the meeting in writing or at the meeting. ~ *Church Representation Rules 2001, Rule 11.(2).*
